

LAST MAN STANDING

RANKING COMPETITION

- We will have 9 ranking events around South Africa focusing on 3 main areas namely Pietermaritzburg, Gauteng and Cape Town.
- Only 180 players will be able to qualify for Last Man Standing South African Championship in 2018
- This will be achieved by inviting the top 60 ranked players per region
- All entries must be confirmed the last Thursday before the event.
- No cash will be accepted on the day
- Failing to participate in the Last Man Standing tour will result in not qualifying for the Last Man Standing South African Championship
- Only Dart South Africa affiliated players are able to participate in these competitions.

RANKING FORMAT AND POINTS

9 ranking events format:

- ❖ Maximum of 150 players per tournament weekend
- ❖ 60 ranked players per region will progress to the Last Man Standing South African Championships in 2018
- ❖ 2 day tournament
- ❖ 15 blocks
- ❖ 10 players per block
- ❖ First 4 progresses to the next round, best 8 5th place player per block to play knockout to get the last 4 players that will make up the 64 players in the knockout
- ❖ Blocks will be played Best out of 3
- ❖ Last 64-32 best out of 5
- ❖ Last 16-4 best out of 9
- ❖ Final Best out of 11

Ranking point's allocation

- 128 = 10 points
- 64 = 20 points
- 32 = 30 points
- 16 = 40 points
- 8 = 50 points
- 4 = 60 points
- 2 = 70 points
- 1 = 100 point
