DARTS SOUTH AFRICA

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS

- 1. Registered members of DSA shall acknowledge that their attitude, commitment, discipline and conduct shall determine the standard of administration and playing of the sport of darts.
- 2. All members shall respect, uphold and promote basic human rights as embodied in the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa.
- 3. Members shall at all times adhere and submit themselves to the authority of the Constitution of DSA and the officials who are tasked with application and enforcement thereof.
- 4. They shall at all times conduct themselves in a manner that does not bring the sport and/or organization (DSA) into disrepute.
- 5. Administrators shall exercise their authority in a fair, just manner and act in such a way as to elicit respect from the members. They shall not abuse the positions which they hold.
- 6. No administrator, or any member, shall be negligent in the performance of his/her duties.
- 7. No member shall undermine the status and authority of an official or another member.
- 8. Members shall use the proper and correct procedures to address issues of concern, grievances, disputes.
- 9. Members shall respect and promote gender equality. There shall be no sexual harassment of any sorts.
- 10. A member shall not insult and/or humiliate another member.
- 11. Members shall at all times use appropriate language.
- 12. Members who are selected/elected to represent the country shall do so with pride, respect, dignity and a spirit of patriotism.
- 13. All members shall at all times while on official duty refrain from being under the influence (intoxicated) of alcohol and/or any other stupefying substance.
- 14. National (Protea) players and/or officials shall acknowledge that national colours are not transferable. They shall abide by the **National Sports Colours Regulations.**
- 15. National (Protea) players shall at all times respect and submit to the authority of their appointed manager/ess.
- 16. Appointed managers/esses shall submit comprehensive reports on player performance and conduct to the NMC and General Council.
- 17. All members are required to adhere to this Code of Conduct. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action against defaulting member.
- 18. This Code of Conduct shall be applied in conjunction with the SASCOC Code of Conduct which shall form part of the DSA Code of Conduct.
